## Winter Warmer Recipe



### TUNA BAKE

**Y** Servings

6 People

#### INGREDIENTS

- 400 grams penne pasta
- 425 gram can tuna in springwater
- 1 cup grated cheddar cheese
- 420 gram can condensed cream of celery soup

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 180C
- Cook the pasta, 2 minutes short of the packet directions, drain
- Add the tuna, half the cheese and season with cracked pepper
- Stir in the soup
- Pour the mixture into a 22cm baking dish and sprinkle with remaining cheese

#### RECIPE NOTES

Optional: Add 1/2 cup peas and corn and chopped parsley before baking
