



#### **Winter Warmer Recipe**



#### **TUNA BAKE**

Servings

People

#### INGREDIENTS

- 400 grams penne pasta
- 425 gram can tuna in springwater
- 1 cup grated cheddar cheese
- · 420 gram can condensed cream of celery soup

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- · Preheat over to 180C
- · Cook the pasta, 2 minutes short of the packet directions, drain
- Add the tuna, half the cheese and season with cracked pepper
- · Stir in the soup
- · Pour the mixture into a 22cm baking dish and sprinkle with remaining cheese.

#### RECIPE NOTES

Optional: Add 1/2 cup peas and corn and chopped parsley before baking
